TRANSPORTATION TO NEW JERSEY AND NEW YORK

SPRING BREAK 2017

Is there transportation to New Jersey/New York?

DOTS provides transportation to Metropark, NJ; Cherry Hill, NJ; and Port Authority, NY for Thanksgiving Break, Winter Break and Spring Break.

When do the buses leave and return?

Thanksgiving Break 2016

Depart: Friday, March 17, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.

Return: Sunday, March 26, 2017

Depart from:

Port Authority 12:00 p.m.

Metropark 1:00 p.m.

Cherry Hill 2:30 p.m.

How much does it cost?

The cost of the trip is \$35 one way and \$60 round trip.

How do I register?

Registration is online at www.transportation.umd.edu. You will need your student ID and password.

When can I register?

Registration begins Tuesday, February 14 at 10:00 a.m., and ends on Friday, March 10 at 4:00 p.m.

How do I pay?

You may pay for your reservation with a credit card or your student account. Student account is the most reliable, as sometimes there is a problem with the credit card processor and the seat is not reserved. Student accounts are charged after the trip.

How do I get my ticket?

You will receive a confirmation email when your registration is completed. You will need your student ID and your confirmation email to board the bus.

Can I cancel if I need to?

You may receive a refund if you cancel either part or all of your reservation by 11:59 p.m. on Monday, March 6.

How much luggage can I take?

You may take two suitcases, which go in the storage compartment, as well as a backpack to keep with you.

Where do the buses pick up and drop off?

Port Authority, New York

Our bus(es) departs from the Cole Student Activities Building on campus and drops off passengers at Port Authority in New York City between 8th and 9th Avenues on 42nd Street. For return trips, our bus(es) will pick up from this area (between 8th and 9th Avenues on 42nd Street) and return to Cole.

Metropark, New Jersey

Our bus(es) depart from the front of the Cole Student Activities Building on campus and drops off passengers at the Metropark station. This station lies within the Iselin section of Woodbridge Township, close to the border with Edison, north of the intersection of Thornall Street and Wood Avenue. It is accessible via Exits 130, 131, 131A or 131B of the Garden State Parkway.

Cherry Hill, NJ

Our bus(es) depart from the front of the Cole Student Activities Building on campus and drops off passengers at **Cherry Hill Mall**: Route 38 Cherry Hill, NJ 08002 Cherry Hill, NJ 08002. N.J. Transit Bus Shelter - Route 38 East at Cherry Hill Mall Drive-in front of the Cherry Hill Towers Apartment Complex.
